- Must be able to exert up to 40lbs. of force occasionally and up to 20 lbs. frequently to move or manipulate objects
- Working environment includes exposure to extremely loud noises in field, Hazardous Chemicals, and Hydrocarbons that may be under extreme pressure for which appropriate safety measures are required
- Ability to work outside in adverse weather conditions for extended periods of time safely
- The ability to inspect and have close visual acuity to perform activities.
- Capable of driving distances of 150 miles or more per day during all types of weather conditions
